Managing body

5.1. The highest management body of non-profit (non-profit) legal entity is the founders.

5.2. The congregation will be convened at least once a year. At the time of its conduct, the seat and the agenda are determined by the presidency a month before the meeting, which informs the founders.

5.3. The foundation's competence is:

- A) Approval of the Statute and Amendment to it;
- B) Determining the main directions of activity, approving plans and targeted programs;
- C) Members of the Presidium, their dismissal;
- D) Decision on changing the goals of a non-profit (non-commercial) legal entity;
- E) Review and approve annual results of activity;
- F) Termination of the non-profit (non-commercial) legal entity and decision on property issues.

Funding sources

The income of the entrepreneurial legal entity is mainly created by donations as monetary and non-monetary. As well as the funds derived from charitable activities, income from economic activities, grants and other permitted funds.

Property and funds

10.1. The property is an inseparable public property.

10.2. Non-entrepreneurial legal entity shall be responsible for his obligations with all his possessions.

10.3. Property of a non-profit legal entity is not subject to privatization and alienation by an administrative procedure. Protection of property rights is ensured by the state.

10.4. Real and movable property of non-entrepreneurial legal entity can be used by the presidium for industrial and agricultural activities permitted by law.
